Winter Parking Regulations

The City of Rhinelanders Police Department would like to remind everyone about the winter parking regulations that will take effect on December 1, 2012. The below attached ordinance regulates overnight parking in the City of Rhinelanders from December 1 to April 1. We would like to remind everyone that in the event of snow removal, vehicles will be ticketed and towed in the downtown area as defined in ordinance 4.02.06(1)(c).

4.02.06 PARKING LIMITATIONS:

(c) All Night Parking Prohibited

1. No person shall park any motor vehicle between 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on the following designated streets:
 - Anderson Street. Between Pelham and Rives Sts.
 - Brown Street. Between Anderson and Frederick Sts.
 - Davenport Street. Between Anderson and Stevens Sts.
 - King Street. Between Brown and Stevens Sts.
 - Rives Street. Between Anderson and Steven Sts.
 - Stevens Street. Between Pelham and Frederick Sts.

Winter Parking Limitations:

2. From December 1 to April 1 no person shall park any motor vehicle on any other street or unmetered public parking lot between 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. At all other times during such dates, all motor vehicles shall be parked only as follows:
 - a. Commencing at 6:00 a.m. of an even numbered date to 3:00 a.m. of the subsequent date, all vehicles may park only on the side of the street corresponding with even numbered addresses.
 - b. Commencing at 6:00 a.m. of an odd numbered date to 3:00 a.m. of the subsequent date, all vehicles may park only on the side of the street corresponding with odd numbered addresses. The Police Department may remove any illegally parked vehicle to a public garage or proper parking place and may charge the cost thereof to the owner of the vehicle.
